Ran 335' of 9-5/8" 32# Seamless J-55 casing and set at 347'. Cemented with 300 sacks of Neat and circulated 45 sacks. Pipe and casing seat were tested with 1100 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement on March 21, 1953. Both held O.K.
