Drilled to T.D. of 3800'. Ran 117 joints, 3790' 5 1/2" 14# J-55 casing. Set 9' below K.B. at 3799' and cemented with 250 sacks regular neat cement. Pumped plug to 3733' at 1:40 a.m., 3/24/59. Ran temperature survey in twelve hours - top of cement at 2665'. Tested casing in twenty-four hours with 1000 psi for thirty minutes - test o.k. Drilled out float collar and cement to 3789' and displaced hole with oil.
