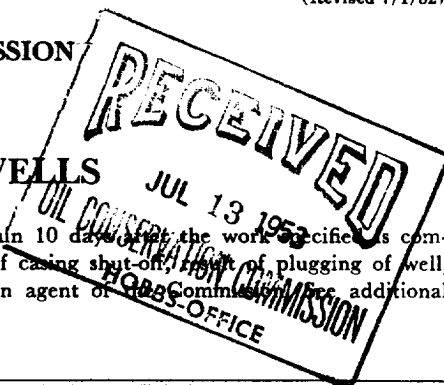

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 2846' of 7" 20# Seamless J-55 Casing and set at 2855'. Cemented with 740 sacks 3% Gel, 185 sacks of Signalite and 200 sacks of Neat. Circulated 225 sacks. Pipe and casing seat tested for 30 minutes with 1000 psi on July 5, 1953, before and after the drilling out of the cement and both held O.K.
