DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well spudded June 25, 1953. It is proposed to drill to a total depth of approximately 3400'.

Ran 300' of 9 5/8" 32# Seamless H-40 Casing and set at 312'. Cemented with 300 sacks Neat and circulated 75 sacks. Pipe and casing seat tested with 800 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement on June 27, 1953, and both held O.K.
