On October 20, 1949, ran 91 joints of new 52" OD 14# 8 rnd thd. H-40 R-2 SS casing with short threads & collars, 2 Baker casing centralizers spaced at 2940 and 2875, Halliburton DV tool at 1348'. Tallies 2935', H-9', set at 2944'. Cemented 1st stage with 625 sax 2% Howcogel and 125 sax Portland bulk cement. Pumped plug to 2908'. On 2nd stage, cemented with 125 sax Portland bulk cement. Plug pumped to 1348'. Job started 9 AM and completed 2.15 PM.

Propose to drill plug and test shut off at 2.15 FM October 22, 1949.
