2. Western Natural Gas Company proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5 (a) of Order R-520.
3. The E. F. King well #1, located 2310' from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 12, T-23-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was originally completed April 18, 1947. When Rule 520 became effective in 1954 this well exceeded the vertical limits of the Jalmst Gas pool and was designated as a gas well in the Langlie-Mattin Oil pool. This well has been deepened, a 5" OD liner cemented from 2918 to 3672', and dually completed as Jalmst Gas (Yates) and Langlie Mattin Oil (Queen). The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
4. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order R-520 as follows:
  - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
  - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
  - (c) The entire non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be assumed to be productive of gas.
  - (d) The length or width of the non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
