Western Natural Gas Company hereby makes application for Administrative approval of a non-standard gas protraction unit comprising the S/2 of NW/4 and the N/2 of SW/4 of Section 12, T-23-S, R-36-E, Los County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Western Natural Gas Company is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its E. F. King lease, Los County, New Mexico, as shown on the enclosed plat.
- (2) Western Natural Gas Company proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 160-acre gas protraction unit in exception to Rule 5 (a) of Order R-520.
- (3) The E. F. King Well #1, located 2310 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 12, T-23-S, R-36-E, Los County, New Mexico, was originally completed April 18, 1947. When Rule 520 became effective in 1954 this well exceeded the vertical
