Gentlemen:

The Aztee State No. 1 is flowing on an intermitter with a plunger lift. The volume of oil produced during a 24-hour period will vary from less than 1/2 barrel to 1 1/2 barrels. As is customary, every attempt is made to obtain an annual test with the well producing at its optimum capacity in order to have sufficient allowable. We then rounded off to the next hignest barrel, which in this instance should not have been done.

We concur that a well's producing capacity is more clearly revealed by a long term overall pattern than a carefully supervised test run under ideal conditions. The production reported on the Form 3-115 is as accurate as is possible with daily gauges and would thus indicate that the well's normal production is with a ratio in excess of 100,000 to 1.
