Dear Sir:

An error was made in the Commission office in regard to the allowable of Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company's N. M. State "A" a/c-1 Wells #3, #4 and #6. All three of these wells are in the NW/4 of Section 21, Township 23 South, Range 36 East in the Jalce Gas Pool. When the gas well plats were originally filed, an 80 acre allowable was requested for Well #3 and a 40 acre allowable for each of the other two wells, a total of 160 acres. At a later date a corrected filing of the gas well plats was submitted to request unerthodox gas proration units for these wells and these cases are new pending before the Commission until a decision is reached in Case 673. Because of this corrected filing, Wells #3 and #4 were each allotted an 80 acre allowable and Well #6 a 40 acre allowable, a total of 200 acres. The wells in question will be assigned the allowable originally proposed pending the cases in regard to the application for the unorthodox gas preration units.
