#### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

**Pitner & West of Breckenridge, Texas treated this well with 1,000 gallons (50-50) acid on November 4th. The acid was loaded down with 250 barrels crude oil, took 150 barrels without pressure and balance went in under 475# pressure. Well was shut down 5th and 6th and after recovering 250 barrels load, averaged 42.50 barrels per day for first 10 days after load recovered. Prior production 5 barrels.**
