#### DETAILS

Above well was completed March 2, 1930 at 3717' as per year log, with initial production of 1600 Bbls. per day. This production gradually dropped until by the end of the month it only made around 500 Bbls. per day and still dropping. After notifying you we started "soring deeper" to increase production. Cored thru formations as follows without any increase in production.

3717 to 3775 Line	3606 to 3608 making 1400 Bbls. water.
3775 to 3776 Sand	Plugged back from 3608 to 3707 w/ Rock,
3776 to 3777 Line	steel cuttings, Lead Plug & Lead Wool
3777 to 3784 Sand	shutting off water. Estimate well now
3784 to 3804 Line	making about 150 Bbls. water.
Line softened up from 3804 to 3806	water increased, to increase in oil.
