NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "A" N.M.
Well No. 2 in N. Cor. SW 1/4 of Sec. 21, T. 23 - S, R. 36 - E,
N. M. P. M., Oil Field, Lea County,
on 19 lb. casing was landed cemented in
formation at a depth of feet on 19
sacks of cement were used.

The method used in placing the ^{Plugging} cement was as follows: Plugging back from 3019 with
19 ft. of rock, 800 Lead Wool & steel cuttings with lead plug on top, Being
put in in 30" lengths and drove down with cable tools to 3788

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of well flowing feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Inside well, No adjacent
property owners.

Additional information: Well was undisturbed 48 Hours, and water less than before
we started coring deeper.
