Killed well. Broke out surface connections. Found top 7" casing loose. Ran Dia-log, found 7" in good shape below 1st collar. Cut 7" off 35' below ground level. Ran 7" Bass Ross Casing bowl. Put on 9" casing clamp. 9-5/8" x 7" Rector Bradenhead and 7" Rector casing head. Ran 99 ft. 2" tubing set at 3113' and swabbed back on production.


