Texas Pacific Coal & Oil Company's State "A" a/c-1, Well #27 located in MWL Unit "F", Sec. 23, T 23S, R 36E, in the Langlie-Mattix Field, is listed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as a gas producing well.

In January, 1953, El Paso Natural Gas Company, informed this office that Well #27 is making excessive fluid in such amount that the fluid is causing a inaccurate measure of the amount of gas being produced. February 1, 1953, a test separator and test tank was connected to the well to measure the amount of fluid that can be produced. The result of this test showed that the well made 55 BOPD on initial test and has been averaging 51 BOPD. The GOR on the initial test was 45,455-1.

This well has been tested daily since February 1, 1953 to date and permission is requested to transport the accumulated oil in the test tanks to our State "A" a/c-1 Battery for Well #17, also located in the Langlie-Mattix Field. At the present, a tank battery is being constructed at Well #27.
