Re: Application to Dually Complete Gulf
Oil Corporation's Alice Paddock No.
3, Blinebry Gas and Tubb Gas Pools,
Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Gulf Oil Corporation's Alice Paddock No. 3, located in the C SE/4 SE/4 of Section 1-22S-37E, was completed on September 4, 1946 at a plug back total depth of 6350'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation's Alice Paddock Lease together with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.

(b) That subject well has 7" casing set at 6953' and cemented with 575 sacks of cement. The well is a gas well producing from the perforated interval from 6150-6250' from the Tubb formation in the Tubb Pool.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

- (1) Perforate the 7" casing within the approximate intervals of 5545-5760' in the Blinebry formation in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 6100' to separate the two pay zones.
- (3) Produce the Tubb Pool gas through the tubing and the Blinebry gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Tubb and gas from the Blinebry is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

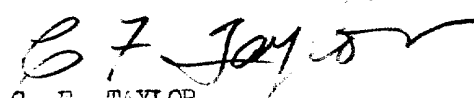
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(g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.

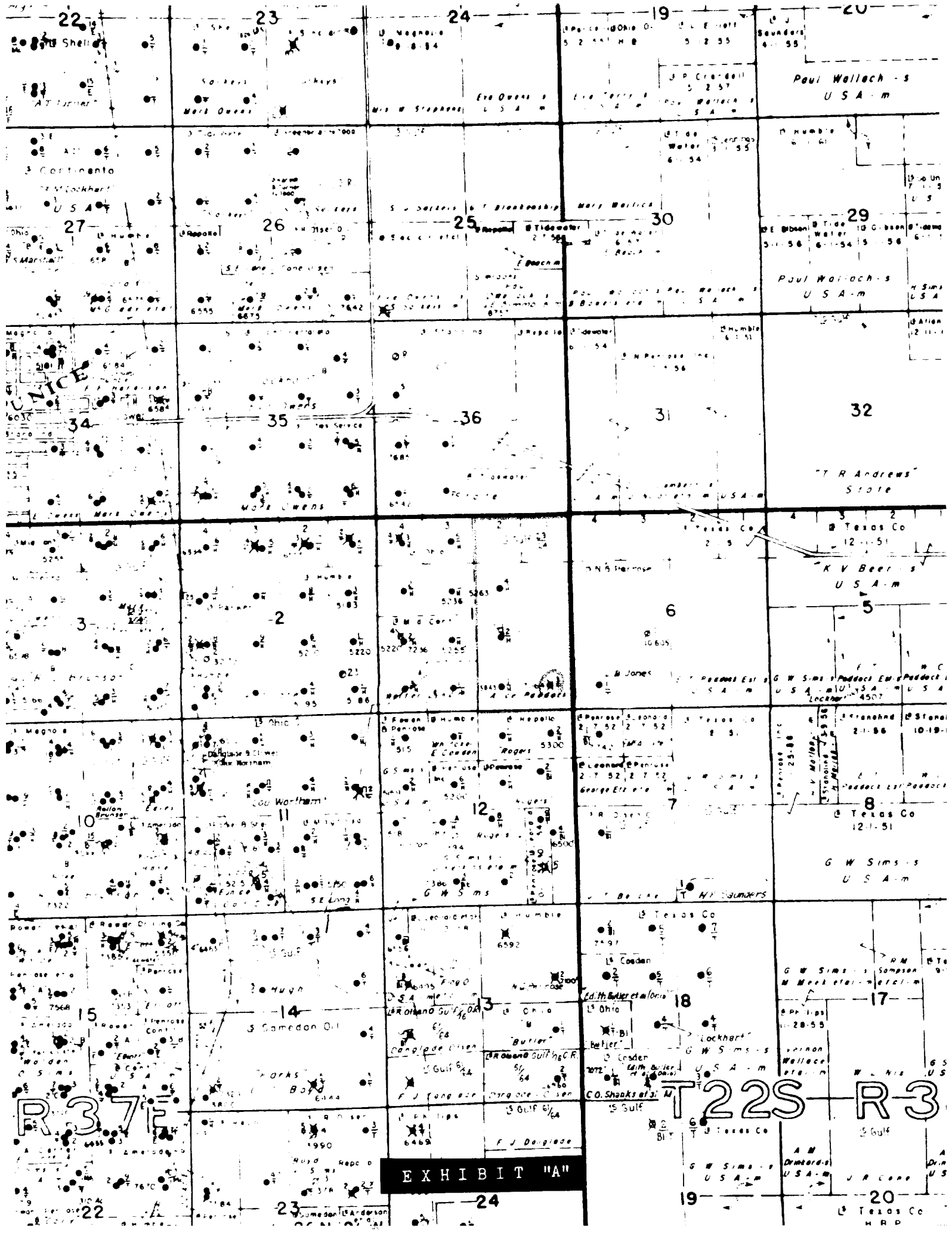
