On January 2, 1946, the 9-5/8" OD 8 Rnd. Thd. 36# Grade H-40 Range 2 S.S. Casing was set in Anhydrite at 2949' and cemented by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company with 1200 sacks Aquagel 2% and 100 sacks neat cement. The plug was pumped to 2916'. The job was started at 10.00 AM and completed 6.20 PM.

We propose to drill plug and test shut off at 6.20 PM January 4, 1946.
