Dear Sir:

As you know, Sun Oil Company recently completed its Annie Christmas Well #1 as a dual completion in the Wantz Granite-Wash Field and in an undesignated Abo reservoir. This well is located in Section 1, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

An application to dually complete this well was filed and a public hearing to consider the application was held on October 3, 1973 under the referenced Case Number.

We have sent a letter to Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr. dated October 24, 1973 requesting a test period of 30 days during which we will collect data to determine whether or not the Abo completion is a non-associated gas well or a high ratio oil well. The letter to Mr. Porter is attached and we apologize for not sending you a copy.

Today we received a telephone call from Mr. Stamets in which he gave Sun oral approval from Mr. Porter to test the well for a period of 30 days at a rate of 1.5 MMCF of gas per day and we are requesting that our Midland Office furnish you Form C-104 and whatever additional information is necessary for you to issue an allowable.

El Paso Natural Gas will receive the gas from this test and we anticipate their line to the well will be completed this week.
