Reference is made to your letter dated June 29, 1981 concerning the packer leakage test performed on our dual completed well, the Walter Lynch #1 (Unit K, Sec. 1, T-22-S, R-37-E).

We apoligize for the delayed response to this problem. As you may know Sun is presently in the process of merging the producing properties of recently acquired Sun Texas Oil Company into Sun's operating system. Extensive realignment of districts, personnel and equipment has taken place. As a result this matter of a packer leak in our Walter Lynch #1 was not brought to the attention of the appropriate department on a more timely basis.

Nevertheless, after reviewing the situation, it has been determined that it is no longer feasible to produce the two formations (Drinkard/Wantz Granite Wash) separately from the subject well. Attached for your reference is Sun's application for commingling approval for the Walter Lynch #1.
