> RE: Lynch #3 and Christmas #1 Blinebry Oil Pool Allowables SW/4 Section 1, T22S - R37E Lea County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Sexton:

American Exploration Company owns Blinebry Gas Pool rights in the SW/4 Section 1, T22S - R37E. They are producing about 1.5 BOPD and 305 MCFGPD from the Lynch-Christmas Com #4 well, which has 160 acres dedicated to it. John H. Hendrix Corporation owns the Blinebry Oil Pool rights in this quarter section and has successfully completed the Lynch #3 and Christmas #1 wells in the Blinebry Oil Pool. (See attached C-103, C-104, and C-105 forms.) The wells are located in the S/2 SW/4 of Section 1.

John H. Hendrix Corporation has requested American Exploration Company to reduce the proration unit assigned to the Lynch-Christmas Com #4 well to 80 acres consisting of the N/2 SW/4 Section 1. (See attached letter.) Since the top allowable for a Blinebry Gas well with a 160 acre proration unit is 1000 MCFPD, having a non-standard 80 acre allowable would not affect American Exploration's ability to produce their well. According to the Special Rules for the Blinebry Oil & Gas Pool, Hendrix can not produce his oil wells while the acreage is dedicated to a gas well.

In order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, we request that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division take all actions available to effect a reduction in N.M.O.C.D.
