

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Blanket bond previously filed.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: Size of Hole, Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented, Sacks Cement. It lists three casing strings: 1 7/8" 13 3/8" 40# New 300 Cemented 300; 2 1/8" 8 5/8" 32# New 2900 " 2000; 7 3/4" 5 1/2" 15.5# New 8000(TD) " 800.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 8000 feet.

Additional information: This well is an offset to our Walter Lynch #2, located in the Paddock Pool (660' from the North and West lines of the SW 1/4 of Sec. One) approximately 5150' deep. We plan to explore the Ellenburger at approximately 8000'.
