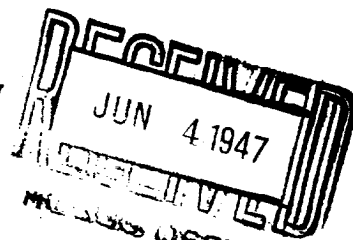

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 6575' Lime. After plugging back from 6575' to 6255' W/35 sks., set Baker retainer @ 5384'. Plugged back W/5 additional sks. to 5343'. Perforated 5-1/2" casing W/160 - 1/2" holes from 5173' to 5200'. Set American Type "Q" Packer @ 5137'. Swabbed well dry. Acidized thru perforation from 5173' to 5200' W/2000 gal. 20% low tension acid. Swabbed 73 bbls. lead oil and 48 B/O and 62 B/W in 24 hrs. In 14 hrs. swabbed 30 B/o and 40 bbls. formation water.
