## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total depth 6575' line. After drilling to bottom of Brinkard zone at 6575' and acidizing with total of 17,000 gals of acid from 6575' to 6440' tested and found barren. Plan to spot cement plug from 6575' up to 6400' then to fill with heavy mud laden fluid from 6400' up to 5350' then spot another cement plug from 5350' up to 5250'. Will leave plug set for 72-hrs then test for hardness and shut off, June 2nd 1947. Will then perforate 5-1/2" casing from 5200' up to 5175' to complete well in the Paddeck zone.
