DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Loaded hole with oil. Pulled tubing. Perforated 5½" casing 5100' to 5180' with 4 shots per foot. Set Guiberson packer at 5044' and treated formation from 5100' to 5180' with 6000 gallons 15% LT acid. Swabbed well and well flowed 18 barrels fluid, 10% acid water. Tested well at rate of 6 bbls. per hour, 12% water. Tested well for 16 hours on 22/64" choke at rate of 5.5 barrels per hour, 7% water. Tubing pressure 175#, GOR 1895.
