DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Loaded hole with oil and acid. Treated gas perforations from 3000' to 3193' with 4000 gallons of Dowell 15% acid. Cleaned paraffin out of tubing and swabbed well 5 hours. Well failed to flow. Swabbed well 8 hours to clean acid out of formation. Well kicked off without swabbing after over-night shut in. Flowed into pits 2 hours, then tested in tank for 2 hours. Well made 17.5 barrels of oil per hour with 805 cubic feet of gas per barrel and 3.2% NGL.
