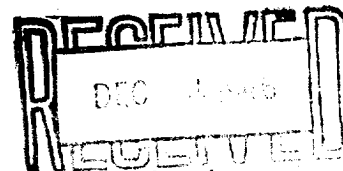

Well unloaded without swabbing. Cleaned into pits 5 hours. Tested 3 hours in tank. Made average of 42.7 bbls. per hour through 3/4" choke. GOR 90%.
