INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be executed and filed in **QUADRUPLICATE** in the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the producer, and two copies retained by the Commission.

the District Office which oil or gas is authorized to be transported by the transporter, one copy shall be retained by the Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operation of the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary transporter involving less than the allowable production for one year the operator shall in lieu of filing a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be transported temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of the temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall be in full force and effect until
