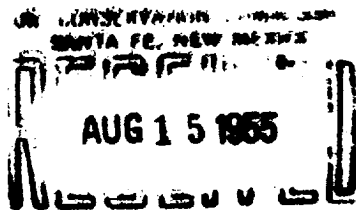

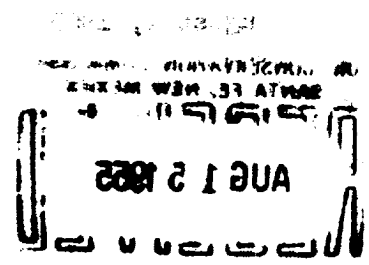

Gentlemen:

This is to request that Humble Oil & Refining Company be granted a permit to dually complete New Mexico State "S" Well No. 21, located 680 feet from the West line and 1890 feet from the South line of Section 2, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This request is made under regulations as set forth in Case No. 728, Order No. R-586 as applicative to the Tubb Gas Pool. In support of this application we present the following information:

1. New Mexico State "S" Well No. 21 is now completed as a gas well in the Elmhurst Gas Pool. It is our plan to dually complete this well by perforating the Tubb gas pay and completing as a dual Elmhurst-Tubb gas well.
2. The acreage to be assigned to the Tubb gas zone will be a 160 acre standard gas unit described as the Southwest Quarter of Section 2, T-22-S, R-37-E.
3. The gas unit will consist of contiguous quarter quarter sections.
4. The gas unit is to be wholly within a single governmental section.
5. The entire gas unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool.
6. The length or width of the gas production unit does not exceed 2640.

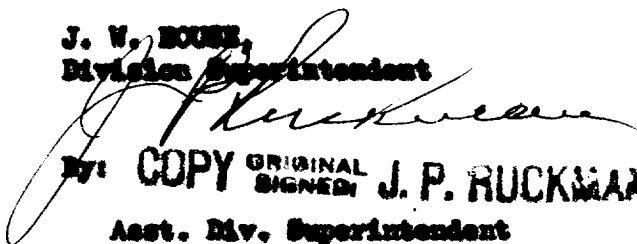
We have attached a schematic diagram which shows the proposed dual completion, a gas unit plat, and a copy of our letter advising all effect operators of this application.

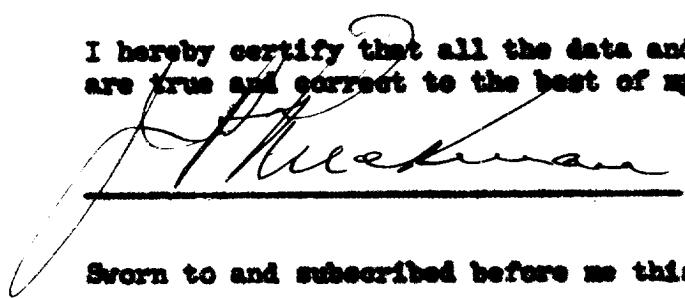

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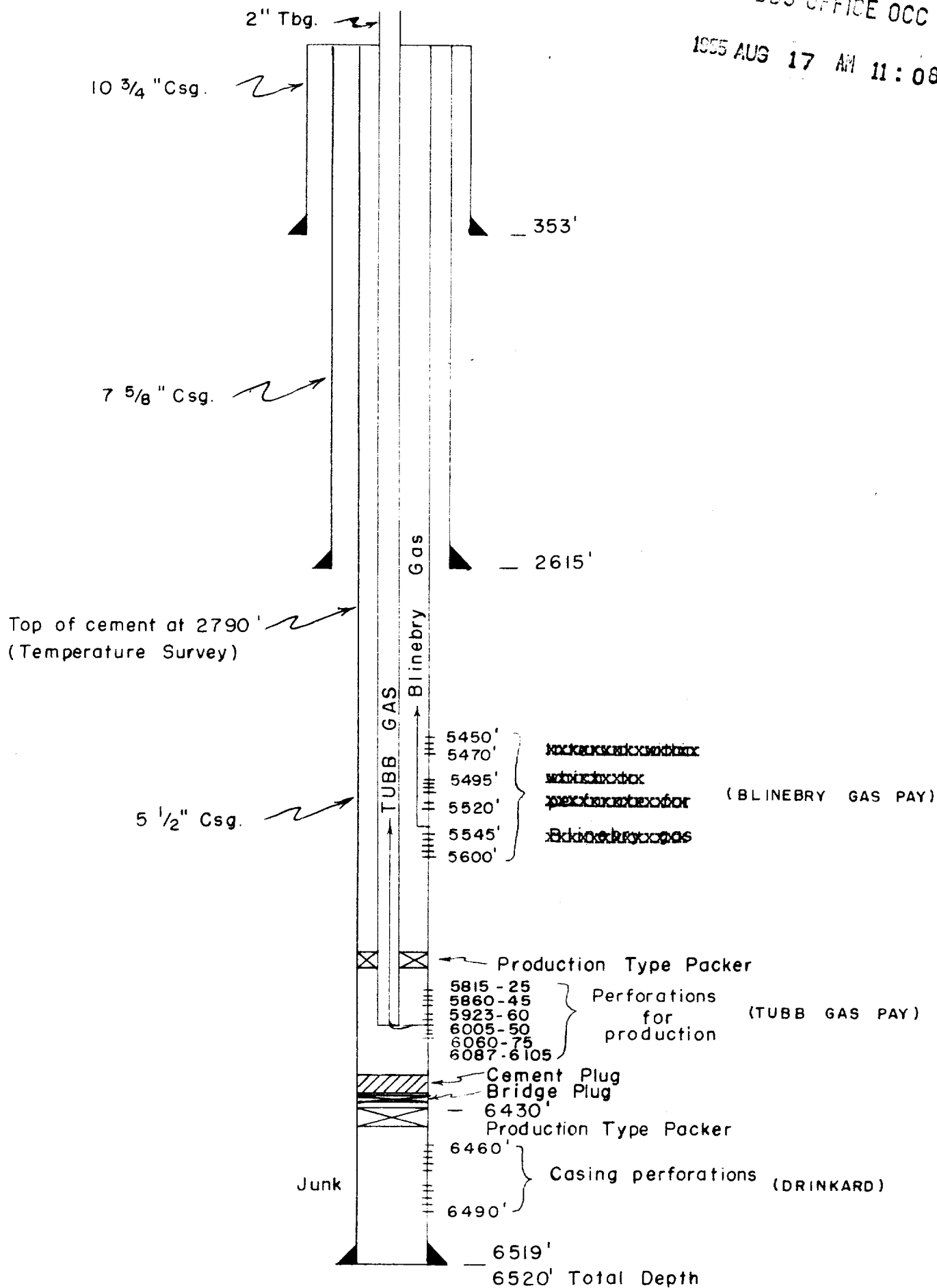
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SCHEMATIC DIAGRAM OF PROPOSED DUAL COMPLETION HUMBLE NEW MEXICO STATE 3-21

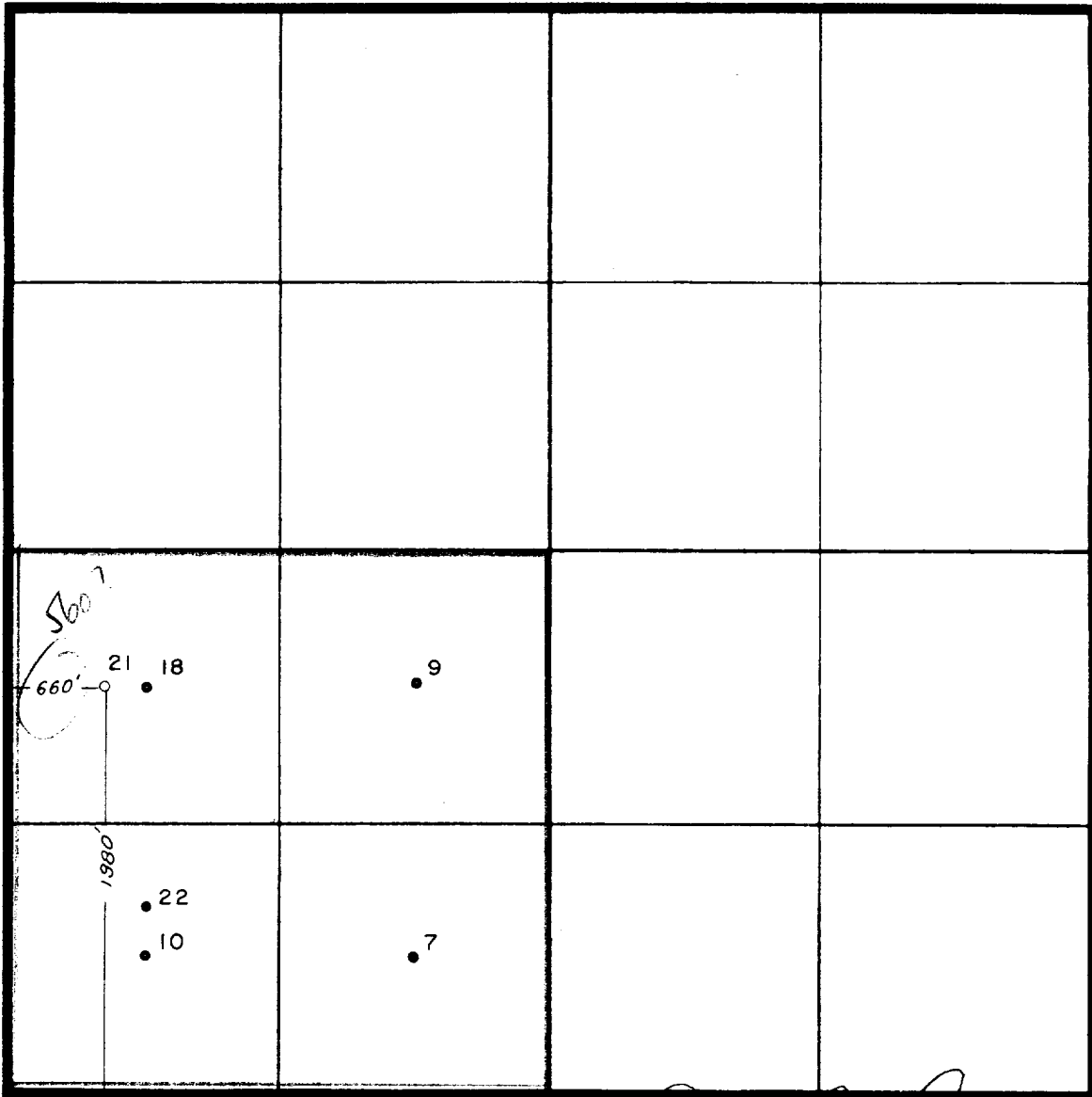
