Second Stage Mar 28, 1941 1000 gals at 3620' to 30'. Well made average of
 6 barrels per hour after swabbing acid water back and cleaning B.S. from pay
 section. Potential 150 Barrels first 24 hours.
 Well made 30 bbls per day natural flow. Increased 120 bbls per 24 hrs after
 acidizing.
