Fill with drilling mud to 3500, Set 15 sks cement on top of 3500.
Pull 8" casing, then fill with drilling mud to top, then set 10 sks of
cement in bottom of cellar and top of hole, then fill cellar with top
soil. With 4" marker to extend 4' above the ground. Set plug and cement with 10
sacks cement at 1190' at top of salt.
