## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 6548' lime. Ran 206 joints 6463.74" of 5½" OD casing, set at 6476' and cemented with 350 sacks. Plug down at 1:05 A. M. September 28, 1948. Cement was allowed to set 30 hours, 1000# pressure was built up, closed valves and allowed to stand 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
