**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

This well was completed in the Paddock Pool on January 12, 1950 and is not currently producing the assigned allowable.

An attempt was made to raise the tubing and was found stuck in the open hole below the casing. There is one joint of tubing below a 3' perforated tubing sub and it is believed the joint is sealed up from total depth to 5122'. It proposed to back off the free tubing, recover the fish and clean-out to T. The well will then be treated with che-plex and acid, tubing re-run and the well returned to production.
