DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well drilled to total depth of 2825' Anhydrite. Ran 2783' of 8-5/8" OD casing set @ 2798' and cemented w/ 500 sax. Plug down @ 3:00 A.M. 11-29-46. First plug failed to stop circulation, circulated cement and recemented.

Cement plug was drilled out of the 8-5/8" casing after having been let set 48 hours and 1000# pressure was applied and all valves closed and pressure did not drop during test.
