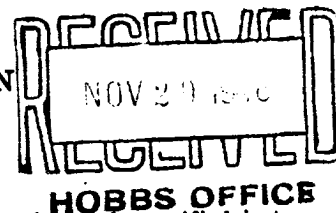

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This is to revise the casing program at this well since it is proposed to complete the well in the Paddock Pay at an approximate total depth of 5160'. The new program calls for the 5-1/2" casing to be set at 5100' and cemented w/ 350 sax. Also due to the acute cement shortage, it is proposed to cement the 8-5/8" intermediate string w/ 500 sax instead of 1500 sax because it is believed that 500 sax will be sufficient since the surface string was circulated w/ cement.
