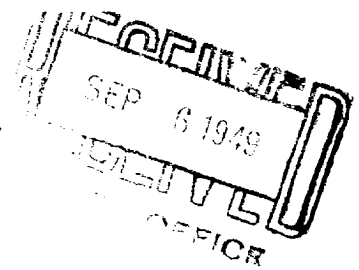

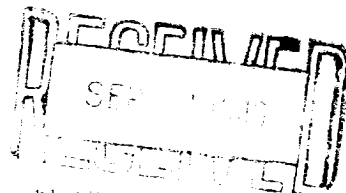

Total Depth 6550' Limb. Ran 179 jts. (6436.57') of 5½" OD 15.5# SR J-55 SS casing set at 6448.09' and cemented with 350 sacks. Plug down 3:01 PM August 29, 1949. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, plug drilled out, 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed, no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed.
