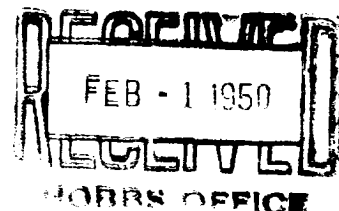

Total depth 2802' anhydrite. Ran 104 joints, 2790.28' of 8-5/8" OD casing set at 2801.58' and cemented with 700 sacks. Plug down 7:15 P.M. January 25, 1950. Cement will be allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut off.
