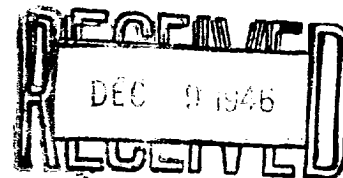

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Dec. 5, 1946 at 10:30 P.M. 72 hrs. had elapsed since setting 9-5/8" casing at 2849' in subject well w/ 500 sacks cement. At this time casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes. As test was OK, plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. As this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.

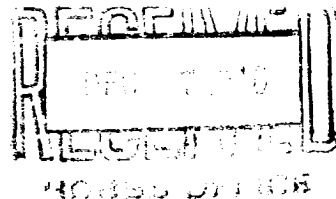
