Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for a reclassification of the Mark No. 7 from an oil well to a gas well, creation of a non-standard 40 acre gas proration unit, and a non-standard gas well location.

Well No. 7 needs to be reclassified as a gas well, per OCD guidelines, as the GOR is higher than 50,000 to 1. A non-standard 40 acre gas proration unit has to be formed for well No. 7 to be dedicated to. The location of the proposed new proration unit is the SE/4 NE/4, Unit H, Section 3, T22S, R37E. Well No. 7 is located at 1980' FNL and 760' FEL in Section 3, T22S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This makes the well an unorthodox location per the Blinebry Gas Pool regulations.

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
