TD 5290'. FBTD 5255'. Well is producing at present through perforations in 7" casing 5115' to 5150' in the Upper Glorieta Formation.

It is proposed to perforate 7" casing from 5180' to 5195' in the Middle Glorieta Formation with 2 jet holes per foot. If warranted, we propose to acidize the perforations from 5180' to 5195' with 2000 gallons 15% NE acid.
