

RECORD OF DRILL STEM TESTS

Mark well No. 8 in 44 ft. of sec. 3, T 22S, R 37E, N. M. P. M.  
Paddock Field, Ira County.

Drill stem tests were as follows:

April 23, 1949 - DST - TD 5160' w/8" packer set - 5090'. Johnson tool open 4 hrs w/15-minute BU (5/8" SS and 1" S choke), 93,400 CF gas to surface in 7 minutes, decreased to 33,500 CF at end of test. Recovered 3960' of oil and 390' of sulphur water in 4 1/2" DP. SP 1025#, BU 1600#, HSP 2400#.

April 24, 1949 - DST - TD 5290' w/5 1/2" packer set - 5165'. Johnson tool open 2 hrs w/15-minute BU (5/8" SS & 1" S choke), 1,300 CF gas to surface in 1 hr, 20 minutes, decreased to zero at end of test. Recovered 150' oil and gas-cut mud and 330' sulphur water in 4 1/2" drill pipe and 120' in 2 7/8" drill pipe. SP 0, BU 1000#, HSP 2500#.
