We then re-perforated from 6500 to 6554 with 162 shots, swabbed 1 1/2 to 2 barrels per hour, with small amount of gas. We plan on acidizing with 300 gallons, and then with 1000 gallons of acid.

T.D. 6600'. 5" OD casing @ 6599, perforated. On July 17, 1946, we acidized with 500 gallons of mud acid, with results of 5 bbls per hour. We then acidized with 1500 gallons regular acid. Acid was going in at 2600', it broke around the casing into the gas zone. We now plan on cementing off this gas zone.
