7" 24# SS casing ran and cemented at 3554 ft. with 300 sacks cement. Total depth 3554. Casing cemented in lime formation. Cement was allowed to set under pressure 72 hours. Hole then bailed and casing tested for 1 hour. Tested O.K. Then drilled plug and bailed dry and allowed to set 1 hour. Tested O.K. again.
