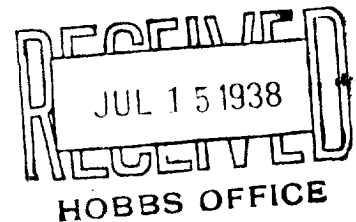

New 8-5/8" casing was set at 1186' in anhydrite and cemented with 600 sacks of cement at 2:30 A.M. July 14th, 1938. Cement returned to the surface when the plug reached 970'. We intend to test the water shut-off on July 18th, 1938.
