DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

10-3/4" 32.75# 8-Thd. New lapweld casing was set in this well at 307' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 300 sacks.

The cement was allowed to stand undisturbed for 72 hours.. The cement was then drilled out of the casing and the hole was bailed dry, and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. The bailer was then run to bottom again to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated so the drilling was then resumed.
