7813' Total Depth, Perforated with 3 holes at 7770' and set Model K Baker cement Retainer at 7759' and squeezed with 15 sacks common cement, Perforated with 3 holes at 7675' and set Baker Model K Cement Retainer at 7662' and squeezed with 40 sacks common cement and built up 3000# Pressure, Perforated with 3 holes at 7560' and set Baker Model K Cement Retainer at 7545' and squeezed with 40 Sacks common cement and built up 3400#. pulled tubing out of hole and will let cement set 24 hours.
