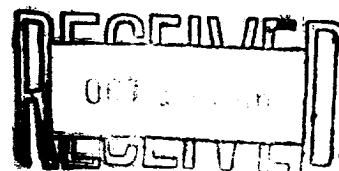

7813' Total Depth, Ran 189 Joints of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " OD 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ , J-55, R-3, Seamless Steel Casing with Baffle Collar set at 7428', Circulating Collar at 7470' and Casing set at 7813' and cemented with 450 Sacks Slow Set Cement, with 130 Sacks pumped through shoe at 7813' and 320 Sacks pumped through circulating collar at 7470', Plug pumped to 7427' at 4:45PM October 24, 1946.
