7698' Granite, Total Depth, Nipped up and picked up 2" EOL Tubing and found top of cement at 7648' and tested Casing with 1200# for 30 minutes and was OK, drilled out cement to 7681' and tested Casing with 1200# for 30 minutes and was OK. Pulled tubing out of hole and ran Lane Wells Gamma Ray survey and will perforate 5 1/2" Casing from 7508-7530, 7545-7590, 7615-7680 with 4 shots per foot.
