7646' Total Depth, Went in hole with tubing and found top of cement at 7601' and tested with 2100# for 30 Minutes and was Ok, drilled out cement to 7639' and tested casing with 1200# for 30 Minutes and was OK. Perforated with McCullough from 7604 to 7634 with 120 Holes, Ran 2" EUE Tubing and set at 7633' with 3' Perforated Nipple on bottom bull plugged and 2-8' Subs on top and 244 Jts of Tubing, swabbed well in and on 3 hour test 1/4" Choke made 85.25 barrels oil Gas Volume 220M Per Day, Gas-Oil-Ratio 322. Well Completed. Drilled out Depth 7639'
