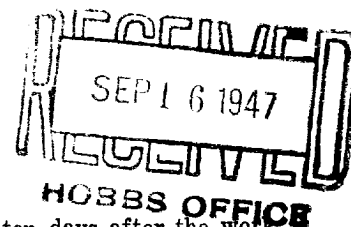

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 6580' Line. This well was acidized with 1000 gallon. Swabbed and flowed in pit for 7 hours. Turned to tank and made 19.22 barrels in 2 hours and well died, changed flow to pit for 4 hours and shut in for 8 hours. After 8 hours, C.P. 1430# tubing pressure 1015#. Opened on 3/4" choke. Well made 83.57 barrel oil in 8 1/2 hours.
