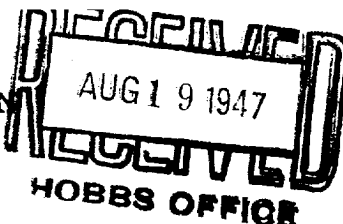

Well was drilled to a T. D. of 2805' in anhydrite, and 92 joints of 8 5/8" O. D. Casing 2792' was run and set at 2803' and cemented with 500 sacks. Plug was down at 4:30 A. M. August 16, 1947. Cement will set 30 hours before drilling plug and testing for shutoff.
