

On June 17, 1946 the 9 5/8" O.D. 30# S. End. Thd. A. S. Smith Electric Weld 8-40-R1479 Medium Yield Casing (New) was set at 2280' in Anhydrite and cemented by Halliburton method with 1200 sacks of Lone Star 2% Aquagel and 100 sacks of Lone Star Heat cement. The plug was pumped to 2287'. Job started at 10:00 P.M. and completed at 4:30 A.M.

Propose to drill plug and test shut off at 4:30 A.M. June 20, 1946.


